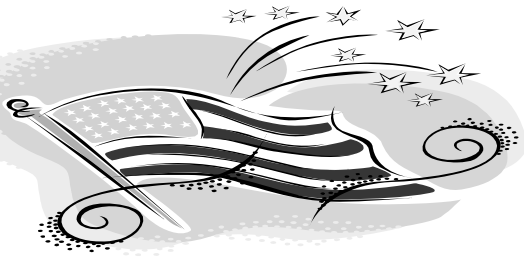

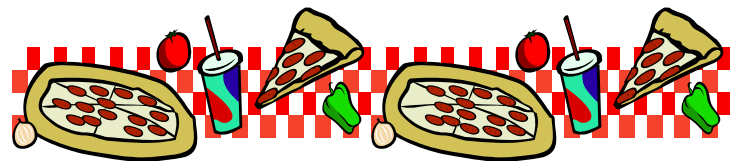

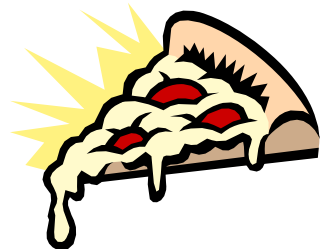

## Keep An Eye Out July 1, 2008

There has been additional vandalism to Ventana Lakes POA property. 50 feet of irrigation line was pulled out of the ground at 104<sup>th</sup> Dr and Rose Garden, and graffiti was painted on the wall at Cimarron and 107<sup>th</sup> Ave. In the case of the irrigation line, we suspect maybe someone was trying to steal copper until they realized it was plastic, and in the case of the graffiti, it was vandalism. We also had items stolen from an unlocked vehicle parked outside in a

driveway overnight near Cimarron and 108<sup>th</sup> Ave, and this resident found their garage door open the next morning. Two garage door openers were stolen from the vehicle, and the thief used one to open the garage door but nothing was taken from the garage.

What can each of us do to help denture crime to Ventana Lakes POA property, and Residential Property? Support Block Watch, "Keep An Eye Out," and CALL THE POLICE if you see anything suspicious or suspect something isn't right.

No matter if you are in the Rec Center, Yacht Club, at a swimming pool, walking around a lake, or just driving through the community day or night always keep watch over things and call the police if you see anything suspicious. Calling the police is the best thing we can do. But do not challenge anyone or get involved yourself because you could potentially get hurt.

Call the police if you see or suspect any crime occurring. We recently spoke to the Peoria Police several times and they continually told us to always "CALL THE POLICE." They said to call 911 if you are not sure if it is an emergency or not. The police non-emergency number is 623-773-8311.

On September 11, 2008 there will be a community Block Watch meeting held at the Ventana Lakes Yacht Club at 6:00pm. City of Peoria Police, Fire, and Animal Control officials will be present to talk to the residents of Ventana Lakes, and answer any questions you might have. We encourage all residents to attend this crime fighting meeting.

## POOL NEWS FROM SPLASH

And don't forget to rinse off the pool water before leaving the pool. You really don't want those pool chemicals on you when you leave the pool?

To our residents and guest who don't normally use the pools, please return the pool furniture where you found them. Roll down the umbrellas before leaving the pool at

the Rec Center and North Park. Please be aware, that any type of GLASS container is not allowed in the pool area. If you require the use of the lift chair at the North Park pool, call the management office or one of the pool monitors listed on the posted board at the pool for instructions on the use of the lift chair.

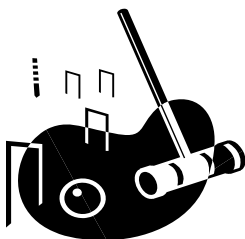

# Community News

## FINANCES-NOT GOOD

The economy being what it is, the last thing we need to hear is that we're going to have to increase our Association assessments. But it's true.

The Finance Committee is projecting a serious shortfall by the end of the year. We're cutting costs where we can and looking for other ways to increase revenue in the interim (ideas, anyone?)

A horticulturist has advised that pruning the palms is only necessary for aesthetic reasons, not for the health of the trees, so the palms on Beardsley and 107<sup>th</sup> Avenue are not going to get trimmed this year. That alone is a savings of \$14,000. If you take a look around you may see other HOA's doing the same thing.

We want to keep our promise about the kitchen, though. The bid we reviewed at our last meeting failed the critical review test, but we have now been able to put out a new RFQ with specifications that will allow us to compare apples to apples. We should be able to award a bid at our July meeting.

THE GARDENS matter was tabled until September while we continue to gather more data. From comments at the June Board meeting, it appears to be a consensus that there will not be a transfer of \$40,000 from the Master to the Gardens reserve.

The Board wants to do the right thing in attempting to unravel another mess created by Lennar Homes when it wrote conflicting documents and walked away. The right thing is not always an obvious or easy solution. It takes time and work. Attend the meetings and read the minutes to keep up to date. The minutes are posted on the web at [www.vlpoa.org](http://www.vlpoa.org) and if you don't have a computer you can view them at the office. None of this is being discussed "behind the scenes." This is covered in the minutes as well.

## CHANGES AT THE OFFICE

You may have noticed a couple of new things on the front page. First, there are no longer "extended hours" on Thursday evenings for working people who might need to stop by. No one was stopping by! Instead, if anyone needs the services of our Management Office staff outside of normal business hours, they need only call and make arrangements. We're hoping this will work out better for everyone involved.

Next, we've instituted a new "Emergency On Call" number. THIS IS NOT MEANT FOR DANGEROUS

EMERGENCIES. If you need the Police or the Fire Department, that's who you should call! But if you see a problem in one of our Ventana Lakes facilities or common areas that you would normally call the Manager about for immediate response, call **623-465-3478** and leave a message describing the problem.

We've also done some physical rearranging. The Board needed a secure working office, and we had concerns about security of files, particularly homeowner files that contain personal information that should not be easily or casually available to anyone other than authorized personnel. Part of this arose from the discovery of many files long considered "missing," which were actually stacked in boxes in the storage shed behind the Management Office. Board Secretary Lori Norris and I have done a rough organization from these many boxes of material left there by City Management, and found invaluable information on our facilities and assets that we will use in implementing the Board's plans for regular maintenance and replacement cycles (which should also assist future budgeting processes.) Lori (with needed volunteers) plans to refine this filing system. It is our goal to set Ventana on a professional management path to keep us running smoothly into the future.

Many of these changes are the first steps in the changes the Board set into motion from its Planning Meeting on May 12. You'll see more as we move forward, so stay tuned.

## **MAYOR, VICE-MAYOR TO SPEAK AT BOARD MEETING**

Both Mayor Bob Barrett and Vice-mayor Cathy Carlat have accepted the Board's invitation to speak at the beginning of the Wednesday, July 16th, board meeting. Mayor Barrett is expected to talk about the state of the city and possibly touch on the upcoming November 4th bond election, which includes \$10 million to build an alternate road for the trucks which currently use Beardsley Road. Vice-mayor Carlat probably will talk about issues pertinent to the Mesquite District which she represents on the city council.

## **CC&R's GOING TO THE ATTORNEY'S**

The Board voted to send the draft Bylaws and CC&R's to Ekmark and Ekmark for legal review, with a required completion date of October 1, 2008 so that we can begin meetings this fall to begin the actual process for change.

## **CITY COUNCIL HEARD OUR VOICES!**

Ventana Lakes residents showed up on June 3 at the City Council meeting to make sure that the ten million dollars for the proposed truck route **AWAY** from Beardsley Road was included in their bond proposal to go before voters this November.

I have to say I was SOOO proud! We had a wonderful turnout and eloquent speakers. GREAT JOB VENTANA LAKES!

Now let's make sure we keep our promise to them – vote in the bond proposal! **And** we'll keep pushing to make sure that road is their top priority!

## **MEMORIAL TREES IN VENTANA**

**Patsy Denne** has come forward with a wonderful idea! She came to the Board and asked for permission to have Moon Valley Nurseries plant a guaranteed tree to replace one lost on our common areas, using donated funds.

This tree is in memory of Sydney Dyer, who passed away last year. She pointed out that about 30 trees have been lost around Ventana Lakes, and she felt this would be a good way to replace them. The Board and everyone at the meeting agreed this is a wonderful way to remember our friends and loved ones and help our community.

You should already have a copy of the current AC guidelines, if you have picked up a copy of the "Community Rules" or "Supplement to the Directory" from the Management Office.
