

Manager's Report

July 21, 2010

1. We have radically trimmed the bushes in the Recreation center pool enclosure to determine where we can remove bushes to improve the appearance of the bushes, and save water. This process will continue through the rest of this month and into early August.
2. Security cameras are up and working at the Recreation Center. Some additional adjustments will be made to the cameras in the next two weeks.
3. We continue to identify mature native trees and bushes on Association property, and remove water from these trees. We hope to meet with a representative of the City of Peoria, to explain this game plan and to ask to remove water from mature native trees along the Peoria right of way.
4. Our Activities Coordinator, Tina Dunn, will be out for medical reasons for the remainder of July, and for an indeterminate amount of time in August. Tina has planned volunteer coverage for the period she will be out.
5. We have requested that our janitorial service open the steam room door when they come to work in the Recreation Center, to allow the tile to dry out. Once aired out, the door can be closed.
6. Ms. Connye Peterson has graciously donated an organ, which will replace the one currently in the Recreation Center. We will, therefore, have an organ available for any resident who might wish to have it. If interested, please contact the Management Office.
